The Women's Shelter is a 20-year-old, private, non-profit community service organization in Columbia, SC.

The Women's Shelter is actually many shelters in one. The emergency shelter can house twelve women at a time and up to 200 a year. The transitional housing program offers women up to two years to address long-term issues. This program has expanded to twelve homes which house up to 26 women.

The Shelter provides programs such as counseling, AA and NA groups, assertiveness training, a codependency support group, health screenings, employment counseling and other life skill training.

The Women's Shelter's ultimate goal is to bring about lasting change in the lives of women in crisis; to help them build stronger, more productive lives.

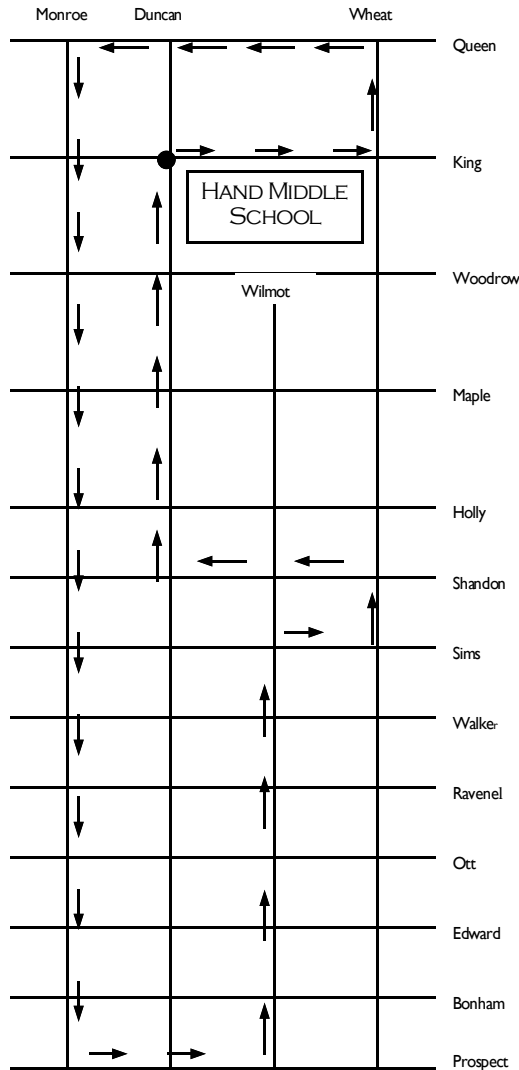
